JOB PURPOSE

To teach general Science as part of the team in the Science department, including Chemistry, Physics & Biology – following the curriculum under the leadership of the Head of Department and in line with the School's strategic plans.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Support and contribute to the school's responsibility for safeguarding students.
- Teach the allocated classes according to the agreed schemes of work under the direction of the Head of Department and departmental marking policy.
- Follow policies on assessment, recording and monitoring pupils' progress.
- Follow policies on reporting pupils' attainment and progress, including participating in parents' evenings.
- Play an active pastoral role as a Form Tutor.
- Contribute to the school's enrichment activities as part of a substantial, regular and frequent co-curricular programme of clubs and/or societies.
- Encourage students' success through the school's da Vinci scheme.
- Work within the school's health and safety policy to ensure a safe working environment for staff, pupils and visitors
- Work within the school's policy to promote equality of opportunity for all students and staff, both current and prospective.
- Maintain high professional standards of attendance, punctuality, appearance, conduct and positive, courteous relations with pupils, parents and colleagues.
- Participate in the school's performance development review programme.
- Work towards and support the school vision and the current school objectives outlined in the School Development Plan.
- Promote high standards of behaviour, effort and attainment in line with school policies.
- Undertake other reasonable duties related to the role required from time to time
