## Fees List for the 2026-27 Academic Year (including VAT where applicable)

### The Termly Tuition Fees for the 2026-27 academic year

- Senior School (Years 6 to 13): £6,665
- Junior School (Years 3 to 5): £5,560
- Junior School (Reception to Year 2): £4,900

The Termly Fee includes:

- Whole-year-group educational UK day trips.
- Pupil Personal Accident Insurance (including dental cover).

*Note: Public Examination Fees are chargeable to parents and will normally appear in the termly invoice for the term in which the examination is taken.*

### Registration and Acceptance

- **Registration Fee: £150.** This is payable on registration and non-refundable.
- **Acceptance Deposit: £550.** This is payable by the parents of each pupil on acceptance of a place.
  - Refund Information: Please see the School's Terms and Conditions for information on how and when the Acceptance Deposit may be refunded.
  - Nursery Deposit: Where a child is moving from Nursery to Reception, a reduction is applied equal to the existing deposit held.

### Optional Extras

All incidental charges are itemised on the termly bill.

### Junior School Wraparound Care (Before and After School Club)

This service is payable in arrears.

After School Clubs run by external providers are charged as advised directly to participants.



## Music Charges

- Music Tuition (Mr Rogers / Mr Harris / Mrs Deacon) - £15.15 per session (20 mins Junior), £22.80 (30 mins Senior).
- Lessons with Peripatetic Teachers are invoiced directly from Peripatetic teachers.

## Catering Charges (per day)

- Senior School (Year 6 to Year 13) - charged on a menu priced basis
- Year 3 to Year 5 - £4.40 per day
- Reception to Year 2 - £4.10 per day

## Other Extras

Examination Fees, Bus Travel, SEN Assessment, SEN Sessions, certain school trips (residential trips and some elective, subject-specific trips), scientific calculator and GCSE/A Level Revision Guides, UCAS application fee (payable either in advance or arrears as charged).

## General Fee Information and Payment Terms

### Fee Review and Billing

- Fees are normally reviewed on an annual basis with increases approved by Governors implemented from the Autumn Term of the Academic Year.
- Fees are billed on a termly basis, in advance.
- For convenience, the annual fees are divided into three equal termly amounts, irrespective of the actual length of each term or amount of formal teaching.

### Payment Methods and Penalties

- Fees are payable on or before the first day of term in which the invoice relates to.
- Fees can be paid monthly in advance to the school, provided the invoice is settled in full by the first day of term, or monthly in arrears through School Fee Plan. Further information can be found on our website.
- Failure to pay fees will result in interest and charges being applied to the account, and the withdrawal of your child(ren) from School.

### Notice of Withdrawal

- One full term's notice is required to remove your child from the school.
- Fees in lieu of notice will be charged if insufficient notice is given.
